## Year 5 Bike Education

On Monday 16<sup>th</sup> of November Year 5 got the chance to learn about road safety. There were three groups and three rotational activities. One was theory. Theory was about learning all the safety equipment and learning road safety. We also had to learn to be aware of dangers of riding a bike, we then did a test. In the other two activities, we got to ride on the road and we had to indicate and scan for cars that might be dangers to us as bike riders. Throughout the days we learnt more about road safety and we learnt all sorts of intersections such as roundabouts, t intersections, intersections and blind spots.

We had to ride around cars by doing head checks and also if you want to turn right on a t intersection or just an intersection you have to do your head checks on a margin of two houses. Then if there was cars you stop and wait for all cars to go past, if there is no cars you can gradually ride into the middle of your lane. Then you have to check right, left and right then if it's safe to proceed you may go.

We learnt about the power position, the stopping signal and where to ride in your lane. We also learnt about the hook turn where we have to be near the gutter and turn your front wheel to the way you want to go, then check up and down the road and if it's safe to proceed you may go. We also have to be aware of cars coming out of the driveway.

Year 5 would like to say thankyou to all the parents and teachers for giving up your time to help us learn about road safety. We really enjoyed learning about Bike Education and it will help us in the future.
